A former Miss San Francisco and Michigan’s Model of the Year, Dawn toured with the band **Asian Eyes**, performed for U.S. troops across California, and appeared as a lead singer on the NBC series *Eerie, Indiana*. Her television credits include *Days of Our Lives*, national commercials, and featured talk show appearances on *Oprah*, *Donahue*, *Montel*, *Geraldo*, the *BBC*, and more! She also worked internationally as a print and runway model in Paris, France and throughout the U.S.

Dawn earned her A.A. at 19 and her B.A. in Journalism at 22, later attending USC Law School. After one year, she made the bold decision to leave Law School— a choice she calls one of her best — and went on to win a Published Opinion from the U.S. Ninth Circuit Court of Appeals, successfully litigating solo against a major California law firm and a U.S. Attorney.

Today, Dawn is known for her dynamic piano remixes of soul, Motown, and pop classics — delivering elegance, originality, and Detroit-bred soul in every performance.
